The Position

A trader will have to price securities and interact with the street, the internal sales force and research to provide accurate prices to various institutional investors. Traders are also required to run spreadsheets, make market commentary throughout the day and come up with interesting and profitable trade ideas. The role requires understanding the market place and being aggressive in marketing ideas and axes.

Training and Development

The Summer Internship lasts 10 weeks.
