Guided Architectural Walk on WU Campus

The Campus of WU Vienna (Vienna University of Economics and Business), completed in 2013, is home to six buildings and generously scaled outdoor spaces and sets new standards in Europe in the construction of universities. The entire area (which has space for 25,000 students and 1,500 employees) is bigger than the size of twelve football pitches: 35,000 m² were built on, 55,000 m² are available as publicly accessible open space.

In accordance with a master plan by BUSarchitektur (Vienna), six internationally recognized architectural firms from Spain, the United Kingdom, Germany, Japan and Austria designed the new campus of WU Vienna. Each realized one building in their respective formal vocabularies. The dominant element of the campus is the Library & Learning Center (LC), which was planned by Zaha Hadid Architects.

For the architecture competitions, a precise concept with clear specifications was developed. Among the requirements were economical, ecological and social sustainability, as well as flexible buildings. The entire campus was built on the basis of a "Green Building" concept: building envelopes and facilities were planned to be as energy-efficient as possible.

Guided tour approx. 1 hour, comprises outdoor areas and the LC Forum, as well as several interiors.
